ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF STP VISION AND POLICY

The Short-Term Programs of Rosedale International strive to challenge its participants to die to self and live a sacrificial lifestyle. It is our belief that as followers of Jesus we are to expect suffering as well as embrace it in the way of Jesus. "I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." (John 16:33 NLT) Looking at Jesus' life, we see that he put the mission of the Kingdom above the comfort and safety the world provides. As his followers, we are not promised an easy, prosperous, or straightforward life. In fact, through the years of church history, many have suffered and died so that the spread of the Gospel could continue. We want to prepare and challenge kingdom workers to develop joy and resilience that is not based on personal comfort. If our peace is found in Jesus then we can say with Paul, "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances." (Philippians 4:11 NIV)

The REACH program involves sacrifices, both big and small.
